BACKGROUND AND HISTORY

SCIP was founded by Miguel and Monica McClure Mancebo in 1997. As successful entrepreneurs and former corporate HR Executives, they developed a plan to educate a diversity of students to tackle challenges that may arise in their careers in the corporate world and ensure they have entrepreneurial skills to be successful in the business world. Having impacted over 20,000 young global leaders, 84% of whom identify as a minority, SCIP elevates global young leaders of all backgrounds to be successful in the business world.

The Mancebos in collaboration with corporate supporters and partners (many Fortune 500 companies) provide critical technical and essential skills that are used to train outstanding students, establishing a win-win situation for both the students and corporations. SCIP provides a long term strategy that enhances their education and prepares them to be tomorrow's young global leaders.

In 1997, the Mancebos began working with the Chancellor of the NYC Department of Education to select students from public high schools for an opportunity to gain insight into Corporate America. Within months, they received over 2,000 applications. Three talented students were chosen after thorough consideration by a committee of business executives. These students met business owners and executives from corporations during the course of the following few weeks. Some of the first corporate site visits were to Avon, JP Morgan Chase, Con Edison, NBC, and Time, Inc. From this point forward, the Selective Corporate Internship Program (SCIP) was formed.


About the Program

SCIP has built on its legacy High School Internship Program (H-SCIP) to create a continuum through its college programs (C-SCIP). Interns are exposed to global business leaders, trained in corporate communications and coached in professional decorum. These activities take place during the school year and during the Summer Executive Leadership Program. SCIP also provides mentors who help the students develop a strong work ethic, and enables them to identify and take advantage of future opportunities for their college and post-college goals.

Throughout the year, SCIP holds leadership and educational summits, diversity forums, and career expos, in which corporate partners attend to recruit prospective employees. In 2017, as SCIP celebrated its 20th anniversary, it divided its programs into four different categories: Business and Finance, STEM, Entertainment, and Hospitality. In fall 2019, SCIP launched its Entrepreneurial Leadership Institute in partnership with the New York & New Jersey Minority Supplier Development Council, Inc.

Amidst the COVID-19 pandemic, SCIP successfully made the transition to communicating exclusively on virtual-based platforms, which proved to be effective. These platforms included Google Docs, Miro, and Slack. In this way, SCIP was able to continue its H-SCIP and C-SCIP Executive Leadership Program and all of its other fellows programs at all levels. We are looking to resume hybrid programs by 2025.

SCIP DEVELOPS GLOBAL LEADERS

College Program (C-SCIP)

SCIP serves its undergraduate population in its C-SCIP Program. C-SCIP students "learn by doing" in this rigorous and impactful program through year-round hands-on business and professional projects. Students learn how to collaborate with each other on a number of team projects through the help of corporate mentorship and professional leadership. Students sharpen their skills in leadership, research, content writing, design, fundraising, and collaborative brainstorming on various fast-paced team projects. These are skills that many students, both past and present, have been able to utilize when applying for high-level jobs and internships in their respective fields. Freshmen and sophomores in the C-SCIP Program are also able to be a part of SCIP's Emerging Leaders Summit.

Additionally, in the Post Covid realm, C-SCIP students are able to feel well-connected to both their community, and their fellow colleagues, due to the work they strive to do. SCIP empowers young leaders to have their voices heard and, in doing so, SCIP successfully invests in their undergraduate population, to make them ready for leadership and team roles in the business world.

MBA Program (M-SCIP)

SCIP's MBA Program, launched in 2015, steers the best post-graduate students to a robust curriculum that propels them to the next level in all of their professional endeavors. Through the support of key partnerships and funding, SCIP's MBA program bridges the growing corporate demands to place skilled diverse global leaders in careers to excel. While with us, students in the MBA Program are immersed in many fast-paced business projects, where they sharpen their leadership skills, corporate mentorship abilities, and necessary team-building skills. SCIP students in the



MBA program have cited SCIP's program as highly effective in their employment applications and job interview. Our program assists many of our students with locating post-graduate and management level opportunities because the criteria used here in the MBA Program are the same standards used to fill those positions in corporate America.


Signature High School Academy (H-SCIP)



The H-SCIP program is a signature, exclusive, and unique program that SCIP is extremely proud of because of our ability to offer high school students the chance to work in team-based projects that sharpen their leadership skills and their ability to work collaboratively with each other on a number of professional projects. Global leaders in the H-SCIP program are mentored by our college fellows for career readiness and professional development. Within this program, SCIP empowers the next generation of future leaders in the world's most in-demand industries.



By working on projects collaboratively, H-SCIP leaders gain firsthand experience into what is expected in the real-world and they feel those effects immediately on their first day with SCIP. Through this program, many H-SCIP leaders are able to better identify their course of study in college. 01 EXECUTIVE SUMMER LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

The Executive Summer Leadership Program runs for ten weeks in the summer, spotlighting hardworking, and highly motivated college students, MBA students, and early career professionals. Future global leaders participate in this program and collaborate with one another on a variety of team projects. They also follow stringent deadlines and present their work to various professionals. Students develop their leadership abilities and work ethic while simultaneously mentoring SCIP's high school fellows.





Networking opportunities are also available here with various high-ranking companies and organizations, as well as job shadowing at corporate offices. Students are also given the chance to go on site visits at various company locations throughout this program. These benefits and the abilities that SCIP fellows have acquired throughout this program make them more prepared and equipped to work in corporate America.

In this program, high school fellows are mentored and supervised by key SCIP college and MBA members.




SCIP'S CUTTING EDGE INITIATIVES
